8-10 Weeks Before Moving	
\square Start major decluttering - you'll need to downsize significantly	
☐ Take photos of items you can't bring but want to remember	
□ Notify doctors, dentist, and current pharmacy	
☐ Research medical facilities near your new home	
☐ Start using up frozen and perishable foods	
6-8 Weeks Before Moving	
☐ Book your moving company (tell them it's assisted living)	
☐ Submit change of address form with postal service	
☐ Notify Social Security, Medicare, and insurance companies	
☐ Contact utility companies to cancel services

1 Week Before Moving
☐ Pack essential medications separately - keep with you

Medical records
Emergency contacts

• Facility paperwork

☐ Confirm moving day details with facility staff
□ Pack as if going on a week-long trip
Moving Day
☐ Arrive early to meet facility staff
☐ Keep "First Day Box" and "Comfort Corner Box" with you
□ Direct movers using your floor plan
☐ Do walkthrough with moving team
☐ Set up your comfort corner first
First Week in Assisted Living
☐ Unpack your comfort corner immediately
☐ Introduce yourself to staff and neighbors
☐ Attend facility orientation if available
☐ Learn meal times and facility routines
☐ Update voter registration
☐ Register with facility's preferred medical providers
☐ Join at least one facility activity

Space Planning Tips

Measuring Your New Space:

- Most rooms are 12x15 feet or smaller
- Doorways are typically 32 inches wide
- Check ceiling height for tall furniture
- Ask about closet space dimensions

⊨ Furniture That Usually Fits:

- Twin or full bed (not queen/king)
- One comfortable chair
- Small dresser or chest

- TV stand (check size limits)
- Small side table

Special Assisted Living Reminders

- Pring a small area rug makes the space feel like home
- Pack familiar scents your usual soap, perfume, or candles
- **Pring pictures of family** great conversation starters
- **Ask about borrowing items** many facilities lend tools, books, games
- Get to know the staff they become your extended family
- Important Numbers to Program:
- Facility main number
- Nursing station
- Family emergency contacts
- New doctor/pharmacy
