REGIONAL HUI COORDINATORS 2019

WHAT IS THE REGIONAL HUI PROGRAMME?

Building on the success of the Kaitaia Regional Hui in February 2018, the 2019 committee wants to expand the Regional Hui programme to five events around Aotearoa. The purpose of these hui are not only to bring aspects of Aotearoa Youth Declaration to regional areas of the country but to create a forum for rangatahi to share their vision for Aotearoa and their community. These discussions are recorded and then included in the Aotearoa Youth Declaration 2019 conference in efforts to include as many rangatahi voices as possible.

These are civic education-based events with considerable discussion-based workshops. We want rangatahi to leave empowered to be active citizens, have a newfound confidence to engage in their wider community, learn about our democracy and social movements.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We are looking for two passionate leaders to plan, organise and deliver five Regional Hui events at the start of February and March next year. These people should have excellent communication, teamwork and organisational skills. They can work independently, with others, and are adaptable and use initiative.

WHAT THE ROLE INVOLVES:

The bulk of the work on the 2018 side is planning, organisation and relationship building. The two coordinators will need to identify venues, partner organisations and schools, funding opportunities, and logistical aspects for each of the five locations. The coordinators will work with the Youth Declaration 2019 committee in creating the educational content, volunteer recruitment, and budget management. The five events will be delivered in the first few weeks of the first school term in February and March. There will be a number of admin tasks after the events.

EXPECTATIONS:

Committee of you:

We hope that you will work well together, to be organised, prepared and always thinking one step ahead. We will appreciate quick responses, updates, and good communication. Above all else, we want you to have fun and create a fun programme for students!

You of the committee:

That you will be supported by Victoria (Coordinator) and Julia (Registrations Officer) throughout the entire process. We will provide help and guidance if required but allow you the freedom to make appropriate decisions also.
